**Project management** is the application of knowledge, skills, tools, and techniques to project activities to meet the project requirements. However, not all cultures and industry sectors approach project management in the same way. This training has been specifically developed to educate Indigenous people, companies and other organizations. The course will be delivered by a certified Aboriginal business with a project management training designation and over 30 years' experience.

The course is multisector, however, specialists in engineering, construction, and professional services may be guest presenters if required to meet the needs of the training group.

### **Course Objectives**

- Provide Indigenous businesses, and individuals including economic development officers, a basic understanding of what the Project Management discipline entails.
- Provide a common language with buying organizations or contractors
- Provide Project Team members the opportunity to identify the processes they work within.
- Provide Project Team members with the knowledge and tools to identify gaps in processes that impact their work.
- Provide Project Team members the ability to participate proactively in process planning and improvement.
- Provide a process through which scope, cost and schedule can be maintained.
